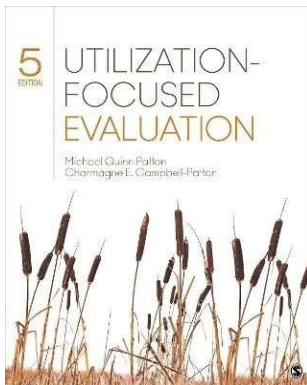
You can continue as a library client even if your studies are ending. Contact the library (e.g. by chat, email) and we will extend the validity of your customer information and update your contact details.

A shortcut to research-based knowledge

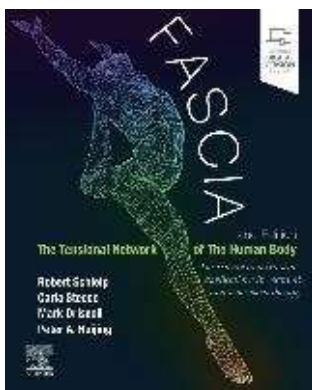

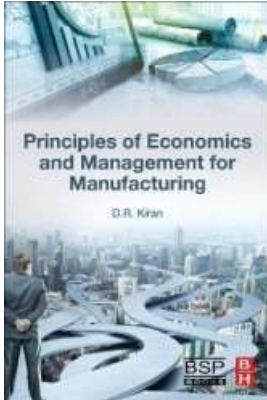
Utilization-Focused Evaluation

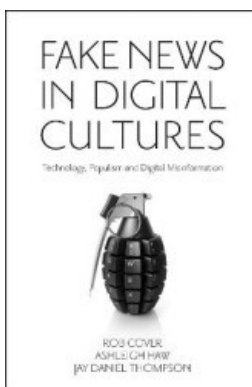
Principles of Economics and Management for Manufacturing Engineering

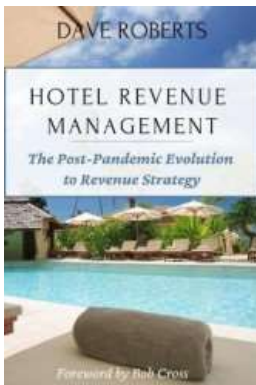
The New Sociology of Ageing

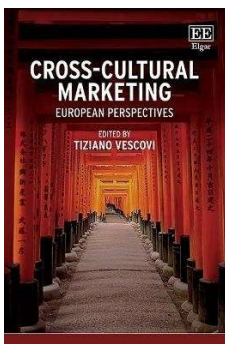
Hotel Revenue Management : The Post-Pandemic Evolution to Revenue Strategy
